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FEDERAL FINANCING BANK

July 30, 1999

Kerry Lanham, Secretary, Federal Financing Bank (FFB), announced the following activity for the month of June 1999.

FFB holdings of obligations issued, sold or guaranteed by other Federal agencies totaled **\$40.6** billion on June 30, 1999, posting a decrease of **\$545.9** million from the level on May 31, 1999. This net change was the result of an increase in holdings of agency debt of **\$35.2** million, and a decrease in holdings of agency assets of **\$495.0** million and in holdings of agency guaranteed loans of \$176.1 million. FFB made **44** disbursements during the month of June, refinanced nine loans on behalf of RUS-guaranteed borrowers, and executed 83 maturity extensions. FFB also received 15 prepayments in June.

Attached to this release are tables presenting FFB June loan activity and FFB holdings as of June 30, 1999.
